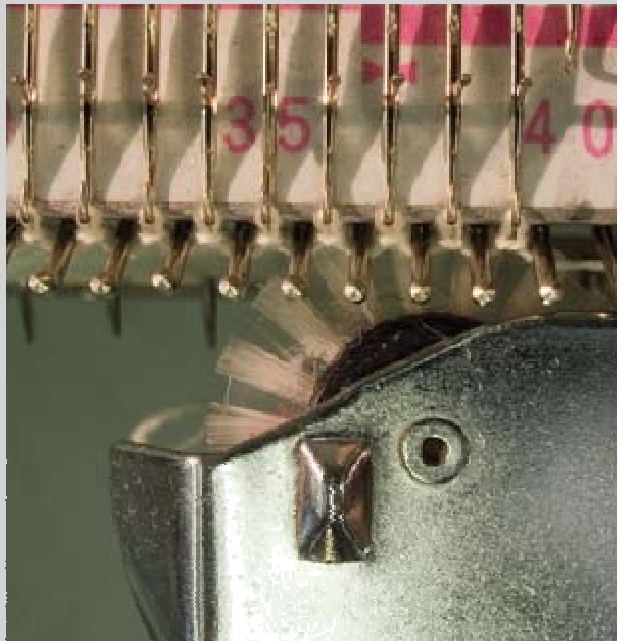

The applicant will be contacted following receipt of their completed application form. If your application is accepted you will be sent payment details. On receipt of payment you will be registered on the course and sent a letter of confirmation.

Enrolment will take place on the first day of the course, an enrolment form will be completed by the course participant.

Places are limited. We will accept applications up until course commencement, should any places remain available. Our policy is to inform late applicants by telephone or email.

Cancellation by the applicant is permitted up to 10 weeks prior to the start of the course (subject to a £150 administrative fee). Cancellation or withdrawal must be received in writing.
